The Veterinary Council of India (VCI) is mandated to fill 15% of All India quota seats in recognized veterinary colleges through a common entrance test i.e National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (Undergraduate) ( NEET-UG ). The NEET (UG) was held on 17<sup>TH</sup> July 2022 and the result was published on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2022. The admissions to 1st year B.V. Sc & A.H couldn't completed by 30th September 2022 as given in the MSVE Regulations 2016.

Thus, the date of admission in to 1st year B.V. Sc & A.H was extended till 31st January 2023 for academic year 2022-2023. However, it has been brought to the notice of Competent Authority that a few seats remained vacant in the veterinary colleges ( both in public and private domain) and the extension of the last date of admission would ensure filling up of vacant seats to a large extent.

The VCI in its meeting dated 2-02-2023 has recommended extension of date of admission with the following guidelines:

- 1. The colleges will follow the extant guidelines of the State / University/ college completing the admission against the vacant seats; as may be available to the college /university
- The admission will be made after giving sufficient notices and time, and following the merit of the candidates.
- The concerned colleges should strictly observe that the minimum prescribed days for the academic session will be taken care by arranging extra classes if need be.

I am to convey, that the Competent Authority has allowed the extension of the last date of admission to 1st year B.V.Sc & A.H, in recognized veterinary colleges from 31st January 2023 to 15th February 2023, subject to the aforesaid conditions.

All Vice Chancellors, Registrars of Veterinary Universities/Agriculture Universities having veterinary colleges and the Director, AHD of States/UTs may kindly take note of the above extension of the last date for admission to B.V. Sc & A.H course at veterinary colleges in the country.
