Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
 मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री  
 be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any data of farmers engaged in animal husbandry and dairying in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Rajasthan;
- (c) the details and the number of common service centres set up to provide assistance to farmers in the country;
- (d) the benefits/facilities being provided to farmers through these centres in the country;
- (e) whether the Government proposes to organise awareness programmes aimed at helping the farmers to gain a better understanding of the latest practices and techniques in animal husbandry and dairy farming which is likely to improve the livelihood of farmers especially in aspirational districts of the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the targets set under the said programme?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
 (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)**

**(a) & (b):** The State-wise details of households having atleast one livestock or poultry including Rajasthan as per 20<sup>th</sup> Livestock Census conducted in the year 2019 is attached at **Annexure-I**.

**(c):** Government-approved CSC 2.0 Project in August 2015 under Digital India - Pillar 3 - Public Internet Access Programme – National Rural Internet Mission to establish at least 1 (one) CSC in each Gram Panchayat (GP) to cover all the 2.50 lakh Gram Panchayats (GP) of the country within 31st March, 2024.

As on 30 June 2023, the total number of active CSCs across the country is 5,32,474, of them 4,24,447 active CSCs are at the Gram Panchayat Level. The details of State/ UT-wise active CSCs are in **Annexure-II**.

**(d):** The number and kind of services being provided currently through CSCs in all the states are at **Annexure-III**.

**(e) & (f):** The Department of Animal Husbandry is organizing awareness programmes across the country, including aspirational districts, aimed at helping the farmers gain a better understanding of the latest practices and techniques in animal husbandry and dairy farming, about various schemes of the department, and how to avail benefits.

There are no fixed targets for the Awareness Programme through Common Service Centres. However, the Department has organized 24,950 awareness camps in FY 2021–22, 2022–23, and 2023–24.
