- (a) whether the Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM) is still operational;
- (b) if so, whether there has been any genetic gain among buffalo population in a sustainable manner in the recent past and if so, the details therefor;
- (c) whether the population of high genetic merit bulls has increased in the country during the last ten years and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of allocation and utilization of funds under the scheme during the last five years, State-wise including Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir, Rashtriya Gokul Mission is continued under the revised and realigned schemes of the Department from 2021-22 to 2025-26 with an allocation of Rs.2400 crore. Buffaloes are developing in sustainable manner since inception of the scheme (Rashtriya Gokul Mission) in 2014. As per Basic Animal Husbandry Statistics average productivity among buffaloes has increased by 20% during the last 8 years that is between 2014-15 and 2021-22. In-milk buffaloes' population has increased by 15.33% during the same period.

(c) Availability of High genetic merit bulls under semen collection has increased from 3250 to 4870 during the last 10 years that is by 49.84% and semen production increased from 82.13 million doses to 130 million during the same period.

(d) The details of allocation and utilization of funds under Rashtriya Gokul Mission during the last 5 years and current year State wise including Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh is at Annexure-I
