755. SHRI M.V.V. SATYANARAYANA:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY &DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of high-tech ambulances for animal, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government is aware of Andhra Pradesh veterinary ambulance 'Dr. YSR Sanchara Pasu Arogya Seva' which are fitted with a hydraulic system, meant for lifting sick animal from the doorsteps of farmers; and
- (c) whether the Government plans to introduce similar ambulance facilities and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) The Central Government has provided 100% financial assistance to 34 States/UTs towards procurement & customization of 4340 Mobile Veterinary Units (MVUs) since 2021-22, under Establishment & Strengthening of Veterinary Hospital & Dispensaries Mobile Veterinary Units (ESVHD-MVU) for delivery of emergency veterinary services at farmer's doorstep. The State/ UT wise detail is annexed as Annexure-I.
- (b) As gathered from Government of Andhra Pradesh, 340 Mobile Veterinary Units in the state are fitted with hydraulic system for lifting sick & recumbent animals from the farmer's doorstep to the nearest veterinary hospitals for necessary emergency treatment and lifting back to farmer's doorstep after completion of treatment.
- (c) There is no such plan in this regard.
