- (a) the number of entrepreneurs submitted application for capital subsidy under Rashtriya Gokul Mission from Andhra Pradesh (AP) during each of the last five years and the current year;
- (b) the number of entrepreneurs which have been provided with capital subsidy out of the above submitted applications from AP;
- (c) whether any application has been rejected; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) to (d) Under Rashtriya Gokul Mission one of the components is to promote establishment of Breed Multiplication Farm (BMF) on hub and spoke model. Under the component 50% capital subsidy maximum up to Rs. 2.00 crore is available for eligible entrepreneurs (Individual/ Self Help Groups/ Farmer Producer Organizations/ Farmer Cooperative Organizations/ Joint Liability Groups and Section 8 companies). Entrepreneurs assisted under establishment of Breed Multiplication Farm are also eligible for 3% interest subvention under Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund. As on date, under the component the Department has received a total of 9 proposals from Andhra Pradesh with complete documentation out of which 9 have been approved by National Steering Committee of Rashtriya Gokul Mission and capital subsidy have been released to 6 eligible entrepreneurs. All proposals received from eligible entrepreneurs have been approved under Rashtriya Gokul Mission.
