- (b) the total funds provided by the Government to promote rearing of domestic livestock in rural areas and tribal areas in the country including Madhya Pradesh during the last three years; and
- (c) the details of steps taken by the Government for the conservation and maintenance of indigenous/ native breed of cows?

- (a) The Government is implementing various schemesfor promotion and development of animal husbandry including rearing of domestic livestock in the country including tribal areas such as National Livestock Mission (NLM), RashtriyaGokul Mission (RGM), National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD), Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF), Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDCFPO), Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme (LH&DCP).
- (b) The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India has releasedfunds under various schemesto the States/UTsincluding Madhya Pradesh in the last 3 years as under:

(c) The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing RashtriyaGokul Mission for development and conservation of indigenous bovine breeds since December 2014. The scheme is important in enhancing milk production and productivity of bovines to meet growing demand of milk and making dairying more remunerative to the rural farmers of the country.

The major steps undertaken for the development and conservation of indigenous breeds under RGM are as follows:

- (i) Nationwide Artificial Insemination program for extension of Artificial Insemination coverage
- (ii) Progeny testing and pedigree selection for production of high genetic merit bulls of indigenous breeds
- (iii) Establishment of Breed Multiplication Farms preferably of indigenous breeds
- (iv) Promotion of In-vitro Fertilization (IVF) technology for faster genetic upgradation of indigenous breeds
- (v) Implementation of genomic selection using genomic chip
- (vi) Sex sorted semen production for indigenous breeds
