VILLAGE BASED ADOPTION OF ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

1054. **SHRI R. DHARMAR:**

Will the Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to adopt villages to develop animal husbandry in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of funds estimated for the purpose;
- (d) the target set for such plans;
- (e) whether Government has identified villages likely to adopt and develop animal husbandry, if so, the details of the villages identified in Tamil Nadu; and
- (f) the timeline for implementation of such plan?

- (a) to (f) No Sir, at present, Government of India has no such plan to adopt villages to develop animal husbandry in the country. However, the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India is implementing various schemes for promotion and development of animal husbandry and dairying across the country such as Rashtriya Gokul Mission, National Programme for Dairy Development, Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund, Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities, National Livestock Mission, Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund, Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme, Livestock Census and Integrated Sample Survey.
