2879. SHRI RAMASAHAYAM RAGHURAM REDDY:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to State:

- (a) whether there is a lack of well-equipped laboratory facilities for quick diagnostics as noted by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Food processing report, which stated that diagnostic samples of cattle taken, needed to be sent to nearby block or district facilities for test results if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to ensure more laboratories facilities, number of multispeciality veterinary hospitals, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has any plan to establish more multi-speciality veterinary hospitals at district-levels to benefit poor farmers, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the number of Mobile Veterinary Units (MVU) sanctioned and operating, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE HON'BLE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & DAIRYING (PROF. S. P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying has a network of laboratories which includes diagnostic laboratories in the States, one Central Disease Diagnostic Laboratory (CDDL) at Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Bareilly and five Regional Disease Diagnostic Laboratories (RDDLs) one each at Bengaluru (SRDDL for Southern Region), Pune (WRDDL for Western Region), Jalandhar (NRDDL for Northern Region), Kolkata (ERDDL for Eastern Region) and Guwahati (NERDDL for NE Region) for early detection and swift response to disease outbreaks. These RDDLs/CDDL services specialized/referral diagnostic services for the States under their jurisdiction.

In addition to above, the country has World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH)recognized laboratories like Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)- National Institute for High Security Animal Diseases (NIHSAD), Bhopal for Avian Influenza, ICAR-National Institute of Foot and Mouth Disease (NIFMD)-Bhubaneswar for FMD, ICAR-National Institute of Veterinary Epidemiology and Disease Informatics (NIVEDI)-Bengaluru for Peste des Petits Ruminants (PPR) and Leptospirosis, ICAR-National Research Centre for Equines, Hisar for Equine Piroplasmosis and Karnataka Veterinary, Animal and Fisheries Sciences University (KVAFSU), Bangalore for Rabies. (b) and (c) Animal Husbandry is a state subject and establishment of laboratories and multispecialty veterinary hospitals comes under the domain of State Government. However, the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying (DAHD) is financially supporting the states/UTs for establishment and strengthening of veterinary laboratories under Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme (LHDCP) as per the State Action Plan.

Also, Department under Establishment and Strengthening of Veterinary Hospitals and Dispensaries-Mobile Veterinary Units (ESVHD-MVU), of LHDCP scheme provides financial support to the States/UTs for operation of Mobile Veterinary Units (MVUs) to provide diagnosis, treatment at farmer's doorstep. Presently, 4016 MVUs are operationalised across the country in 28 states. The details of state wise Veterinary Institutions are placed as **Annexure -I.**

(d) The details of sanctioned and operational MVUs state/UT wise are placed at Annexure-II.
