Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the 40 livestock projects recently inaugurated;
- (b) the extent to which it is likely to be expected to benefit regions such as Maharashtra, particularly the Jalgaon Lok Sabha constituency and Chhattisgarh;
- (c) the extent to which the Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) and the National Livestock Mission (NLM) be utilized to support these projects, and what role will these schemes play in the development of the livestock sector in the country including Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh;
- (d) the extent to which the inauguration of the NLM - EDP Dashboard enhance transparency and public accessibility to information about these projects in the country especially for stakeholders in regions like Jalgaon Lok Sabha and Chhattisgarh;
- (e) the measures the Government is implementing to promote entrepreneurship within the livestock sector, and are there specific initiatives targeting young entrepreneurs and small businesses in Maharashtra, including Jalgaon Lok Sabha and Chhattisgarh, if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) whether any specific measures are being implemented to support young entrepreneurs and small businesses if so, the details thereof in the sector?

ANSWER

THE HON'BLE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING
(SHRI RAJIV RANJAN SINGH ALIAS LALAN SINGH)

(a) A total of 41 livestock projects were recently inaugurated under the National Livestock Mission – Entrepreneurship Development Programme (NLM-EDP) and the Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) scheme. Their details are provided in Annexure I.

(b) and (c). Both NLM-EDP and AHIDF are implemented across the entire country. Out of the 41 projects inaugurated, 10 projects under AHIDF are from Maharashtra and one from Chhattisgarh, while 5 projects under NLM-EDP are from Maharashtra. These projects aim to enhance the livestock, poultry, feed, and fodder sectors, in addition to generating

employment. They play a crucial role in fostering the development and growth of the animal husbandry sector and the rural economy.

(d) The dashboard will facilitate smooth implementation of the programme, improve monitoring, and streamline follow-ups on pending cases with banks and other relevant authorities. The public will also be able to view projects implemented in their locality.

(e) and (f) Extensive awareness like seminars and camps, publicity, video Conferences were carried out to promote the scheme. In order to encourage the State Governments, the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying is providing assistance to the State Governments to create awareness, facilitate the beneficiaries for preparing the Detailed Project Reports, establishment of help desk to guide the beneficiaries. In this regard, 100% central assistance are provided to the State for awareness and publicity under National Livestock Mission (NLM) scheme. Besides, during the during Regional Review Meetings instructions are also given to the States.

Department has established Programme Management Agency (PMA) to assist beneficiaries. The Department has also established a system to track and facilitate applications pending with banks and other agencies. Additionally, a Central Level Bankers Committee (CLBC) has been formed to follow up with banks for loan sanctions. In addition, recently, to promote NLM-EDP and AHIDF scheme in the region, "Entrepreneurship Development Conclave" was held on 13.01.2025 in Pune, Maharashtra. In the said conclave, the beneficiaries were awarded certificates of appreciation, and 21 NLM-EDP projects were inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying. In addition, a certificate of appreciation was also given to the best performing states and banks to encourage more and more successful implementation of the scheme.

Under NLM-EDP, 50% capital subsidy up to ₹50 lakh is provided for establishing poultry, sheep, goat, pig, horse, camel, and donkey breeding farms, as well as feed and fodder units. Eligible entities include individuals, FPOs (Farmer Producer Organizations), SHGs (Self-Help Groups), JLGs (Joint Liability Groups), FCOs (Farmer Cooperative Organizations), and Section 8 companies. Any individual above 18 years of age can apply, subject to fulfilling all requisite documentation.

NLM-EDP is structured into smaller units to facilitate the development of small businesses. Details are provided in Annexure II.

The following activities of different unit size are eligible under NLM Entrepreneurship Scheme:

- i. Establishment of Parent Farm, Hatchery, brooder cum mother unit of Rural poultry birds with minimum 1000 parent layers for production of Hatching Eggs and Chicks.

Poultry Unit Size (Female + Male)	Max amount of capital subsidy
1000 + 100	₹ 25 lakhs

- ii. Establishment of sheep and goat breeding farm with minimum 100 female and 05 male and in its multiple as follows.

Goat/ Sheep Unit Size (Female + Male)	Max amount of capital subsidy
100 +5	₹10 lakhs
200+10	₹20 lakhs
300+15	₹30 lakhs
400+20	₹40 lakhs
500+25	₹50 lakhs

- iii. Establishment of Pig breeding farm with minimum 50 sow and 05 boar and 100 females and 10 males. The maximum subsidy ceiling for different components varies from Rs. 15.00 lakh to Rs. 30.00 lakh.

- iv. Establishment of fodder value addition units such as preparation of Hay/Silage/Total Mixed Ration (TMR)/ Fodder Block and storage of fodder. The maximum subsidy ceiling is Rs. 50.00 lakh.

- v. Establishment of Camel, Horse and Donkey breeding farm
