Drugs Prohibited / Restricted for Veterinary Use under Applicable Regulatory Provisions

Note: This Annexure is intended as a ready reference for users of the Standard Veterinary Treatment Guidelines (SVTG). It does not create, modify or supersede any statutory provision. The notifications/orders issued by the Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying (DAHD) and other competent authorities, as amended from time to time, shall prevail.

A. Drugs Prohibited / Restricted under Applicable Regulatory Provisions

Sl. No.	Drug / Drug Group	Scope of Prohibition / Restriction
1.	Diclofenac and its formulations	Prohibited for veterinary use.
2.	Ketoprofen and its formulations	Prohibited for veterinary use.
3.	Aceclofenac and its formulations	Prohibited for veterinary use.
4.	Colistin and its formulations	Prohibited for manufacture, sale and distribution for use in food-producing animals, poultry, aquaculture and animal feed supplements.
5.	Nimesulide and its formulations	Prohibited for veterinary use.
6.	Chloramphenicol and Nitrofurans	Prohibited for import, manufacture, sale and distribution for use in food-producing animal production systems.
